Vineyard

Soil : Clay and limestone.

blend : Merlot 90%. Cabernet Franc 10%.

surface area: 9,3 hectares (22,23 acres) : 8,3 hectares (19,76 acres) de Merlot et 1 hectare (2,47 acres) de Cabernet Franc.

Average age of vines : > 60 years(1,7ha, 4,2 acres), 20>years< 50 (4,6ha, 9,9 acres), 5 years (2ha, 4,9 acres).

Density of planting : 6000 vines/ha.

Culture / Itinéraire technique

Mechanical work : intercep under the vines (0% glyphosate), mow inter-row, topping.

Manual work: Pruning, removed unwanted new shoots, debudding. Manual work is favored for their precision, respect for the plant and to limit our carbon footprint.

Spray treatment: based on bio-control product (35%), phytopharmaceutical products (non-CMR) and optimized use according to climatic and phenological conditions and ungraded natural manure.

Vine growing / Aging

Harvest : Machine-made and manuals for the oldest vines.

Vinification : Bioprotection" winemaking without sul-fites during the vinification. Concrete and stainless-steel tanks with temperature-controlled system.

Aging : 12 months in barrels (French oak, 4 coopers), with 100 % new barrels every year and ceramic amphora.

Bottling : At the property.

Tasting notes :

"Sporting a deep garnet-purple color, the 2019 Haut Veyrac sashays out of the glass with gregarious scents of black forest cake, morello cherries and stewed plum plus suggestions of potpourri, rose hip tea, nutmeg and woodsmoke. The full-bodied palate is laden with spiced red and black fruit layers, supported by plush tannins and just enough freshness, finishing long and perfumed."
